

Puppy Application

We only place our puppies in good homes. This application is the first step in our evaluation process to make sure that the Eurasier is the right breed for you. All questions must be answered. We require applicants to participate in a brief call prior to final approval. Approved applicants will be placed on a waiting list in the order their application and deposit was received. ***The price of a puppy is \$5,000 and is not negotiable. Payment is due in three installments:***

➤ A \$500 non-refundable deposit is due after your application is approved. This goes towards the total payment and confirms your position on our waitlist.



- A second payment of \$1,500 is due when you are assigned a puppy. We assign each puppy to the best fitting home based on waitlist order, top choices, and disposition.
- The final payment of \$3,000 is due the day you take your puppy home. Full payment of the remaining balance is due before the adoption takes place. We accept Venmo and Cash App. We also accept credit card payments with a 5% processing fee on our website.

Eurasiers can become very picky eaters so we recommend avoiding regularly feeding raw or home-cooked. Kibble is the most reliable way to give dogs all the nutrients they need.

Veterinary Care

Our puppies receive their first vaccinations at 8 weeks of age. Those vaccinations include Distemper, Adenovirus 2, Parvovirus, and Parainfluenza. Depending upon your local conditions your reputable vet may recommend additional vaccinations and we urge you to consider their professional advice. As a condition of sale, you agree to follow all state and local laws regarding any additional vaccinations as required.
